Training

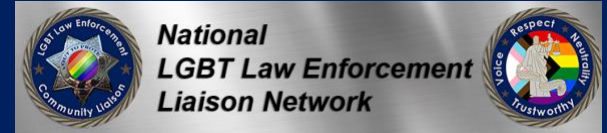

Our courses are certified by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training. California law enforcement personnel earn CPT credit.



LGBT Liaison Network



We provide the only national network for LGBT Community Liaisons. Membership is free to employees of law enforcement in the United States for the purpose of sharing information and problem-solving.

This network is guided by a leadership team of experienced LGBT liaison officers from around the United States.

Scholarships & Grants

Since 2009, we have provided scholarships to LGBTQ+ students enrolled in a basic law enforcement training program. Our belief is that “out” members of the LGBTQ+ community working in law enforcement is essential to fully serving our community. The “John Reinert Scholarship” offers \$1000 to LGBTQ+ law enforcement role models.

We provide program development and training grants to law enforcement agencies.

The “Kevin Burke LGBT Liaison Development Grant” helps law enforcement agencies wishing to start an LGBT Liaison program.

We also offer grants for agencies to provide LGBT awareness training and a library grant that provides a copy of our book for any public or school library in the United States.
